

## FAQ eBook Subscriptions

<b>Does the price depend on the number of users?</b>	The price depends on the number of campuses and users. Extra charges should be paid in case there are more than 2 campuses, or more than 15'000 users.
<b>What does the eBook format provides for?</b>	The content is available online in the eBook format with the possibility to export each separate paper of the book to PDF.
<b>Why should an institution provide the list of Campuses and the number of FTE Researches to take out a subscription?</b>	We require this information to calculate the subscription price.
<b>What are the terms and conditions of the trial period?</b>	To subscribe for the 1-3 month trial access Libraries are required to provide their URL, full address, contact name, e-mail, IP addresses. The trial period includes the access to the usage statistics.
<b>Which volumes are available as eBooks?</b>	All our publications are available as eBooks. The list of volumes can be downloaded in Excel format the <a href="#">AllTitles.csv</a>
<b>How one can access the Usage Statistics?</b>	The usage statistics is available for downloading after logging in a personal account.
<b>Do you provide the COUNTER Compliant statistics, BR1 or BR2?</b>	Yes, our usage statistics is COUNTER Compliant, BR1.
<b>Do you use any content preservation services?</b>	All the content published by TTP is archived with <a href="#">Portico</a> .
<b>Do you provide MARC records?</b>	We provide MarcRecords, MetaData, XML Files, ONIX, ToC, Cover.
<b>Do you permit customers to get an off-campus access (ex. EZProxy)?</b>	An off-campus access is allowed for customers, if not misused.
<b>What are the terms of subscription for the eBooks?</b>	Refer to <a href="#">eBooksAgreement.pdf</a> for details.
<b>Do you use DRM (Digital Rights Management)?</b>	All our data is DRM free.
<b>How can one get a remote access?</b>	Customers can get the remote access through their user name and password.
