

# Preface

The Seventh China International Conference on High-Performance Ceramics (CICC-7) was held from November 4 to 7, 2011, in Xiamen, China. Continuing the success of conferences organized in Beijing (CICC-1, 1998), Kunming (CICC-2, 2001), Shenzhen (CICC-3, 2004), Chengdu (CICC-4, 2005), Changsha (CICC-5, 2007) and Harbin (CICC-6, 2009), CICC-7 offered an international forum for the presentation, discussion and review of the latest advances in science and technology of high-performance ceramics. The response to the conference announcement was positive and more than 720 experimental and theoretical scientists from about 23 countries and regions were attracted to the Conference. The organizers received more than 850 abstracts of which 662 were chosen for presentation. These contributions covered almost all the aspects of the field.

The conference received more than 400 manuscripts from the participants. After review process, 396 papers were finally accepted for publication in the proceedings.

The Editors would like to thank the members of the Organizing Committee and the International Advisory Committee for their efforts and successful preparation of this event.

We would like to thank all colleagues who have devoted much time and effort to organize this meeting.
