### **PREFACE**

This book collects the papers presented at the 26<sup>th</sup> International Symposium on Ceramics in Medicine (Bioceramics 26), held in Barcelona, Spain, from November 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>, 2014. The 26<sup>th</sup> Bioceramics Meeting is the Annual Meeting of the International Society for Ceramics in Medicine, that brings together researchers and clinicians, in order to establish an open forum for presentation and discussion of the latest advances in the field of bioceramics research and their medical applications. Since the first meeting, the publication of a conference book has been a distinguishing mark of Bioceramics Symposia, and this book provides continuity to this tradition.

While bioceramic materials are in clinical use worldwide since the 1970's, their applications are increasing in many specialities, and the focus in bioceramics research has evolved, facing new challenges in the fields of regenerative medicine, tissue engineering, drug delivery, gene therapies and nanomedicine, among others. This evolution is in fact reflected in the papers gathered in this book.

The book includes papers on a number of topics covered in the Bioceramics Meeting. They have been organised in different sections: Additive manufacturing of ceramics and composites; Biostable ceramics and tough ceramics; Calcium phosphates; Cell-material interactions; Cements; Ceramics for drug delivery; Clinical applications; Coatings, surface engineering and interfaces; Composites and hybrid materials; Glasses and glass-ceramics; Nanoparticles and nanostructured ceramics; Preclinical models: animal studies; Scaffolds. The papers were selected after a peer review process of the abstracts and full papers, which involved more than 40 reviewers. We are grateful to all of them; without their collaboration this book would not exist.

We would also like to thank the Scientific Committee and the Local Organising Committee for their excellent work that made the Symposium possible, as well as all the sponsoring institutions and companies that have supported Bioceramics 26.

We hope that this book will provide knowledge and inspiration to the readers, and will contribute to further advance in the field of bioceramics for clinical applications.
