<p><b>Do you provide the list of volumes available on <a href="http://www.scientific.net">www.scientific.net</a>?</b></p>	<p>The up-to-date list of all the volumes published on the website can be generated in a .xsl file and downloaded through the link <a href="#">AllTitles.csv</a> on the <a href="#">Downloads</a> page. The list is generated on the fly.</p>
<p><b>Which periodicals are included in the Web Packages?</b></p>	<p>Our Web Packages include 14 periodicals. <p><b>Which publication dates does the subscription period include? Are the back volumes available for subscription?</b></p>	<p>The basic WEB COMPLETE package allows subscribing to the volumes published during the current year from January 1st to December 31st.</p> <p>Subscribers who wish to access back volumes can choose the desirable archive depth for the WEB COMPLETE package. It can include the volumes published in 2 recent years, 5 recent years or all back volumes down to the first issues of each periodical.</p> <p>For more information, please refer to the <a href="#">Subscription Rates</a></p>
<p><b>What are the subscription terms for the mid-year subscribers?</b></p>	<p>The mid-year subscribers pay full amount and get access to all the volumes published from January 1st to December 31st.</p>
<p><b>Why should an institution provide the list of Campuses and the number of FTE Researches to take out a subscription?</b></p>	<p>We require this information to calculate the subscription price. If more than two campuses are subscribed or the number of users exceeds 15 000, extra charges should be paid.</p>
<p><b>Do subscribers sign a license agreement? How one can get acquainted with the Terms and Conditions?</b></p>	<p>We have a license agreement for subscribers. It can be sent by email upon request.</p>

<b>What are the terms and conditions of the trial period?</b>	To subscribe for the 1-3 month trial access Libraries are required to provide their URL, full address, contact name, e-mail, IP addresses. The trial period includes the access to the usage statistics.
<b>How often the subscription prices are updated?</b>	The prices are updated yearly in July/August.
<b>Do you send newsletters for subscribers in order to keep them up-to-date with new content, features and/or services?</b>	The newsletters about new volumes published are sent out monthly.
<b>Is there an option to see the usage statistics and get reports?</b>	The usage statistics is available in the administrative account. There is an option for downloading usage reports.
<b>Is the statistics COUNTER Compliant?</b>	We provide COUNTER Compliant usage reports.
<b>Do you use any content preservation services?</b>	All the content published by TTP is archived with <a href="#">Portico</a> . The archiving with CLOCKSS will be arranged soon.
<b>Do you provide MARC records?</b>	We provide MarcRecords in MARC21 format, XML Files, MetaData, ONIX, ToC, Cover.
<b>How often are MARC records updated?</b>	MARC records are updated twice per month.
<b>Do you support the Shibboleth authentication system?</b>	Unfortunately, we do not support Shibboleth system.
<b>Do you permit customers to get an off-campus access, remote access, and remote access from outpost centers or satellite campuses?</b>	The remote access and off-campus access are allowed for customers, if not misused.
<b>Do you use DRM (Digital Rights Management)?</b>	All our data is DRM free.

<b>Are there any restrictions for simultaneous access?</b>	There are no restrictions for simultaneous access.
<b>Is the resource available in a mobile version?</b>	Scientific.Net website is built in responsive design. It can be accessed via mobile devices.
<b>Do you provide licensees with perpetual access rights to all content paid for during the term of the subscription? Will the licensee have archiving rights?</b>	Licensees receive the right of perpetual access via <a href="http://www.scientific.net">www.scientific.net</a> . We also entitle Licensees to archive the content.
<b>Are users allowed to share insubstantial amounts of the content with third parties?</b>	Users are allowed to share insubstantial amounts of the content with third parties (colleagues) for non-commercial scholarly use.
<b>Is there any content that becomes available in open access on the website after an embargo period?</b>	Currently we do not implement the delayed open access model of publishing. There is no embargo periods for the content published upon basic terms. Unless the authors of a paper ordered the open access option, the access to the publication would require subscription on permanent basis.
<b>Are authors allowed to self-archive in their institution's limited-access repositories, open-access repositories and public servers such as PubMed Central, RePEc, or SSRN?</b>	Authors are allowed to self-archive full versions of their papers published by TTP in internal institutional repositories with limited access. Provision of the open access to this content is not allowed unless the authors had ordered the open access option and paid an additional fee to make the paper freely available on Scientific.Net website. The general rule is that the amount of information provided for open access in institutional repositories or free public servers should not exceed the amount of information freely available on Scientific.Net website for unregistered users.
<b>Are the lecturers, who have the access to the resource, allowed to send copies of articles to the students enrolled in MOOC (Massive Open Online Courses)?</b>	Such cases are considered individually. The lecturers should address their requests for issuing a permission to <a href="mailto:authors@scientific.net">authors@scientific.net</a> .
<b>Do you support customer branding of your site (e.g. using Libraries' logo)?</b>	The option of customer branding currently is under development.
